Manager's Corner

It's that time of year again. Time to put away school shoes and backpacks. Time to take a break from making school lunches and setting that early morning alarm. Ahhhhh, summer! Welcome to all of the new families who have made the choice to make SSTC their summer home and welcome back to our returning members who decided to return for another sun and fun filled season.

Please take the time to go through your membership packets once you receive them. Make sure that you have the correct member and or sitter cards. Check out the updated social calendar and go over the lesson schedule that will be included in your packet. Also, please find time to read through the rule book, especially members who are joining us for their first summer. There is information that you will need to familiarize yourself with in that book. If

something in your packet is incorrect, please visit the office so that we may make the necessary corrections for you.



Lesson sign ups must be made in the office. Please do not call them in. We can better

serve you if you come in person to sign up your children. Swim lesson sign ups are always challenging, especially when it comes to putting children in the correct levels. Lesson sign ups begin on June 10th and end on June 21st. All lessons begin on June 24th.

Our snack bar will be open full time as of opening day, June 8th. Hours are posted on the snack bar doors. You can prepay and start a tab if you so choose. We ask that if you are giving your children permission to go into the snack bar by themselves to make purchases that you please sign your tab sheet. Your signature will give our snack bar employees permission to sell to your children when they visit the snack bar. Without your signature, we will not sell items to your children.



Also, I ask that you treat the employees in all areas of our club with

kindness and respect. We will service you to the best of our ability at all times and we ask for your patience and consideration while on the grounds, swimming in the pool or purchasing meals in the snack bar.

We do allow guests to visit with our members. Our guest policy is that the same child can visit 5 times per month (15 times per season) and adult guests are allowed 5 times per season. I do keep track of all guests visiting the grounds and when you have a guest that comes close to our limit you will receive an email stating how many times that guest has left to visit our grounds.

The guest fee is \$10 per person with children 2 years and under free. We do sell a guest card that is \$40. All



guests as well as guest cards can be purchased at the gate house when you arrive at SSTC. PLEASE NOTE THAT THERE WILL BE NO GUESTS ALLOWED ON SSTC GROUNDS THE DAY OF OUR KIDS FAIR. THIS IS A MEMBER ONLY EVENT.

Our grill pits are lit nightly for anyone who would like to eat dinner at the club.

Members bring in their own food and store it in



coolers or in the refrigerator on the screen porch. Please clearly label packages that are yours so that no mistakes are made when it comes to what belongs to whom.

Announcements will be made for members to come to the office if they wish a grill for that night. Grills are lit between 4:45 and 5pm (weather permitting).

SSTC is the perfect place to host a party. If you are thinking of hosting an event at the club, you will need to visit the office and complete a party planner and leave a

deposit. Members do not pay any extra fees for the facility. You simply pay for your guests on the days of your

event. There is a \$50 deposit required for parties of under 20 people and a \$100 deposit required for 20 or more people. Please see a manager if you are interested in hosting an event at the club. **NO PARTIES WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE DAY OF THE KIDS FAIR.**

Take the time swim a few laps in the pool or watch your children play in the kiddie pool.
